3. To engage in community service and establish partnerships with various industries/institutions in a measured and focused manner, with an emphasis on behavior, mental functions, and individual mental processes.



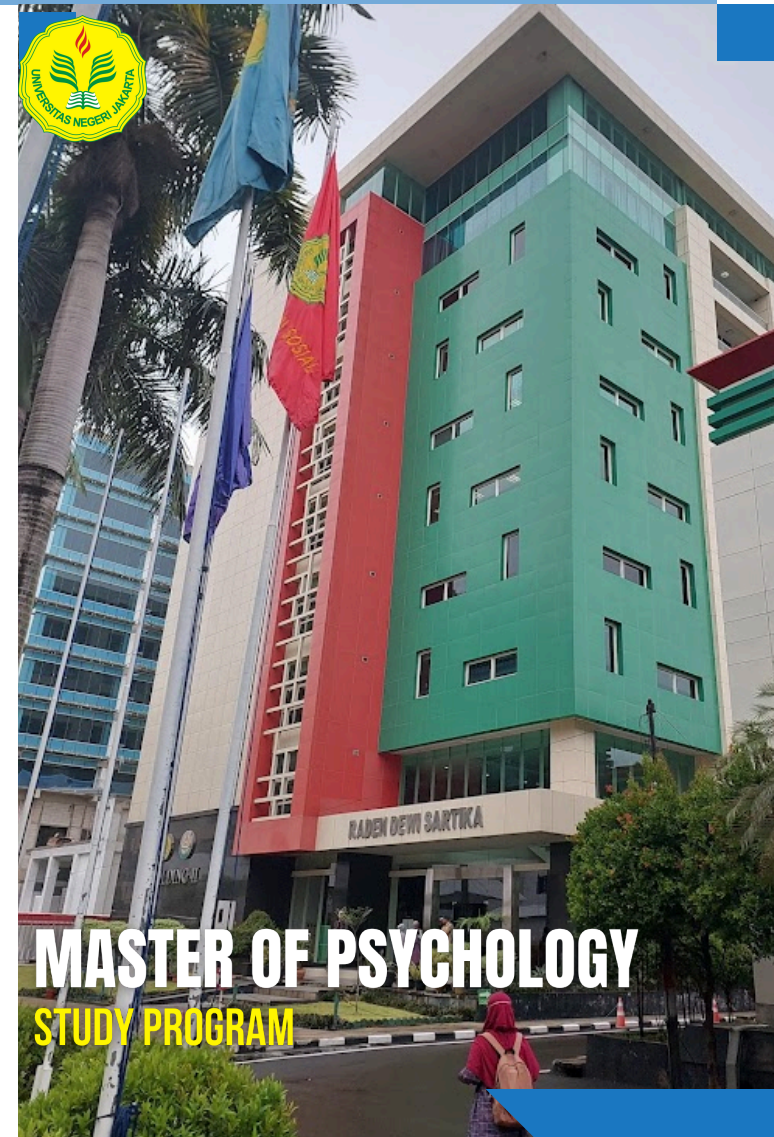
ABOUT THE MASTER'S PROGRAM IN PSYCHOLOGY
